PUTIN'S SHADOWS ONAFRICA THE CENTRAL AFRICAN REPUBLIC MODEL

More than a month after the death of Evgenij Prigožin, Wagner fighters remain active in the wars of Mali, the Central African Republic, Libya, and Sudan. Meanwhile a new coup staged in Niger is welcomed by a local population weaving Russian flags and slogans against France. Wagner operatives ally with the local autocrat and militia commanders who can pay for their services in cash, or with profitable mining concessions for precious minerals such as gold, diamonds, and uranium. Wagner has been in the Central African Republic since 2018 to protect the besieged president, Faustin-Archange Touadéra, who doesn't take a step without his presidential guard, all white, all Wagner men. While most of the local population welcomes this presence, a report from the organization The Sentry, an independent investigative body, denounces the violence and brutality of the Wagner group mercenaries, accused of summary executions, robberies, looting, and violence against women. Yet the responsibility of these crimes against humanity has not been clearly established. This documentary on the field reports about the contradictions linked to Wagner presence in Africa, with the testimony of Marat Gabidullin, a former Wagner mercenary, and author of the memoir "In the Same River Twice".
